

- b. Intakes within Target Community consisted of 55 animals from Santa Clara County Animal Care Services and 2 from VCA San Martin (local vet servicing the community)
- c. Intakes from Outside Target Community were animals abandoned at Petco Gilroy where FOSMAS is an adoption partner having an adoption center at that location
- d. Animal that died or were euthanized were for liver failure or FIP
